A GREAT VARIETY OF CULTURAL AND ENTERTAINING SIGHTS

Many elaborate temples add a tranquil element to Hong Kong's whirr, and Tin Hau temple has a surprisingly urban location, considering its dedication to the Goddess of the Sea. It did once occupy the shoreline, but the city's growth saw land reclaimed from the sea around it, leaving the temple marooned inland.

Having been leased to the British for 99 years, milky tea is a revered tradition here – enjoy your cup with a serving of local dim sum. While it's easy to think all the bright lights are the sum of today's Hong Kong, you need only walk or board a tram for the short jaunt west into Western to discover a side of Hong Kong that is more traditionally Chinese but no less high-energy.

You'll discover the real Hong Kong to the east of Central, too, in Wan Chai, Causeway Bay, and beyond. Amid the residential towers are restaurants, shopping malls, bars, convention centers, a nice smattering of museums, and – depending on fate and the horse you wager on – one of Hong Kong's luckiest or unluckiest spots, the Happy Valley Racecourse.



Please remember to carry your **Suite Key Card and a coloured passport copy (passport file on phone is sufficient)** whenever going ashore as this is your only valid identification for reboarding the vessel.
