DUTCH HARBOR, ALASKA, USA

MANY OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES LIKE HIKING, SPORTFISHING, KAYAKING, AND BIRDING

With Bald Eagles soaring overhead, emerald-green volcanic peaks chafing the clouds, and raw ocean scenery as far as the eye can see, this far-flung destination is the definition of remote and wild.

Part of the outlying Aleutian Islands archipelago, which spirals out across the Bering Sea into the wilds of the Pacific, Dutch Harbor offers a dramatic backdrop and rich military history – as one of the few pieces of US soil to be directly attacked by the Japanese during World War II. The town settles into the embrace of a vast deepwater harbour, which helps to protect from the unpredictable churn of the Bering Sea.

Enjoy hikes along coastal trails to birdwatch among more than 100 different species – and look on as huge clouds of cawing seabirds float on gusts of wind, filling the air with their raucous calls. Dutch Harbor is famous for its crab fishing industry – a dangerous, challenging pursuit – and the town is well known to many Americans as the setting of the television show Deadliest Catch.

The Aleutian WWII Visitor Center and the Museum of the Aleutians provide extensive information on WWII in the Aleutians, prehistory, the Russian period, Unangan (Aleut) culture and recent history. A visible reminder of the Russian past is the Holy Ascension Cathedral, the oldest cruciform-style Russian Orthodox church in North America and a National Historic Landmark (On 7th May closed for Russian Orthodox Easter Services).

THE MUSEUM OF THE ALEUTIANS (MOTA)

FACE-TO-FACE INSPECTION IN DUTCH HARBOR, ALASKA, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

A mandatory face-to-face inspection for ALL GUESTS will take place shortly after our arrival in Dutch Harbor, Alaska. This inspection will take place on board in The Show Lounge, Deck 5 from approximately 8:15 a.m. onwards. So, please carry your customs declaration (one per family) duly completed and signed for the inspection. Your passport will be handed to you at the entrance of The Show Lounge before approaching the inspection desk, and once the US CBP Officer is ready to receive you. After being processed by the CBP Officer, you are cleared and can proceed ashore carrying your suite key card, plus any government issued photo ID, and these will be the only form of ID you will need to carry with you when going ashore in all US ports.

Due to the remote location of the port, we have only one US CBP Officer attending the ship for clearance, therefore we thank you in advance for your patience and cooperation in completing the mandatory inspection. We'll make announcements by PA system indicating when you should proceed to the inspection, so please listen carefully to the announcements.

DUTY FREE ALLOWANCE

U.S. residents have a duty free allowance of \$800 per person. We as a carrier are required to submit a report of our on-board sales to CBP on arrival. Therefore, please note, that upon your final disembarkation in US, CBP officers may question guests found to have exceeded their allowance.
