## MANTA, ECUADOR

### *The city's economic importance*

As home to Ecuador's second-largest seaport, Manta is one of the most important economic cities in the country. So, far from rustic shores and a sleepy village, visitors to Manta can expect a modern urban hub, complete with vast beaches, high rises, city slickers and lots and lots of fish. This is the city that has a giant tuna statue welcoming its visitors, so it is no surprise that seafood is high on everybody's list of important things. What was once a small fishing village has today grown into a mighty industry and ultra-fresh seafood - mostly tuna - takes center stage. Thus, no trip to Manta is complete without sampling at least one of the local dishes. Foodies will salivate at the opportunity to taste not only amazing tuna ceviche but also exquisitely prepared squid, octopus, lobster, and inspired South American-style tapas. If tasting the city's legacy isn't enough for you, then the Archaeological Museum of the Central Bank of Manta boasts an excellent collection of ceramics from the Manteño-Huancavilca culture that flourished here between 800 and 1550 A.D. Manta's seafood, beaches and boutiques might be enough for some people, but it is worth noting that picturesque Montechristi is only about 20 minutes away. Jump on a colorful (and colorfully authentic) Chivas bus for the short ride to the home of the Panama hat - which does not originate anywhere near Panama! The enchanting village has retained much of its faded Spanish elegance with its milliners by far its star attraction.

The below excursions will depart from the **Pier ashore**. As a courtesy to your fellow guests and to allow the punctual departure of your excursion, we ask all participants to proceed to the **Pier ashore** 10 minutes prior to your departure time. If you are late, unfortunately the transportation will not wait. Port information and full tour description are available on the interactive TV system in your suite for each port of call for this cruise. **Please note**, guides are not allowed to enter the port area: according to Manta's Port internal regulations, tour buses will depart from the pier to the port entrance gate without a guide. The guides will meet the tour buses at the port entrance gate, where the explanations will begin.

**Return from the Tours:** After the tours have concluded, the buses will drop guests off at the cruise terminal, Please note that buses are not permitted to return to the pier, from the cruise terminal, guests will take the In-port shuttle bus back to the ship.

Today in Manta, we are offering two separate shuttle bus services for your convenience:

1. In-Port Shuttle Bus: Operates continuously between the ship and the terminal throughout our stay. Please be aware that walking within the pier is not permitted, and this shuttle service is not affiliated with Silversea Cruises.

2. A complimentary Shuttle Bus Service: This shuttle will operate between the Port Gate (departing from the parking lot behind the terminal) and Espigon, which is located in downtown Manta. We recommend that guests disembark the ship at least 15 minutes before the shuttle departure time at the designated pick-up location. Guests must use the In-Port shuttle bus to access the terminal building, as walking is not allowed. The drive to the city takes approximately 15 minutes, depending on traffic conditions.
