Color and Culture on the Coast

Lima splashes color, culture, and movement across Peru's long desert coast. Founded in 1535 by Spanish conquistador Francisco Pizarro, the city has grown into one of the world's largest desert metropolises—an enormous oasis where nearly 10 million residents live in dramatically varied conditions. From seaside districts lined with cafés and modern high-rises to sprawling hillsides dotted with informal settlements, Lima is a place of striking contrasts. The city's personality is shaped by a blend of ancient history, colonial influence, and contemporary life. In the historic center, grand colonial architecture surrounds the iconic Plaza de Armas, where the Basilica Cathedral and Government Palace evoke centuries of political and religious significance. Here, cobblestone streets lead to ornate balconies, lively markets, and neighborhoods where traditional craftsmanship still thrives alongside bustling urban commerce. Just beyond the urban core, pre-Columbian ruins rise unexpectedly between modern buildings, reminding visitors of civilizations that flourished long before the Spaniards arrived. Major museums such as the Museo Larco and the National Museum of Archaeology, Anthropology, and History showcase treasures from these ancient cultures—intricately crafted ceramics, textiles, gold ornaments, and artifacts from societies that built extensive adobe cities and engineered remarkable mountain settlements. Together, Lima's past and present weave a story as complex and layered as the desert landscape that surrounds it.

HOSPITALITY DESK

A local representative will be available at the Shore Concierge Desk upon ship's clearance for 2 hours. The representative will be able to answer detailed questions and to direct guests to their desired locations. Complimentary brochures and maps may also be available.

SHUTTLE BUS SERVICE

A complimentary Shuttle Bus Service will operate between the Pier and Inka Market (pick-up location). We recommend arriving at least 10 minutes prior to the shuttle bus departure time at the pickup locations. Distance to Lima downtown: Approx. 1 hour 15minutes' drive one-way/ in each direction. Heavy traffic can be expected.

Independent Arrangements: A secondary In-Port Shuttle Bus will operate throughout our stay on a continuous basis from the Pier to Av. Manco Capac nbr 182, **Callao** (drop off point). Guests deciding to return to the ship independently via taxi, Uber or other independent arrangements should leave their taxi at the drop off location Av. Manco Capac nbr 182, **Callao** and then take the Inter-Port Shuttle Bus back to the pier. Taxis are not permitted to enter the Port of Callao and access from the Port Gate is not permitted.

IMPORTANT: NO TAXIS, UBER OR ANY INDEPENDENT ARRANGED PRIVATE VEHICLES ARE PERMITTED TO ENTER THE PORT.
