Discovering Norfolk Island's Story

Marooned between the Queensland coast and New Zealand's North Island, Norfolk Island is a place of perfect isolation. Once a remote penal colony feared for its brutality, it later became the sanctuary of the Bounty mutineers - who made the arduous journey thousands of miles from Pitcairn to start afresh here in 1856. Local guides - often direct descendants of the Bounty mutineers - share the island's history firsthand. A stunning 360-degree painting tells the Bounty's story in immersive detail. The Kingston and Arthur's Vale Historic Area is a living museum, and between 1788 and 1855 the island was home to a notorious and brutal penal colony, first settled by the British in 1788. Earmarked for the worst of the worst, the sheer remoteness of the location was said to render any escape attempt impossible. The same unique setting that made it such a notorious outpost also formed a remarkable island ecosystem. Birdwatchers can explore the subtropical rainforest and shores, home to 25 rare and endemic bird species sheltered by fragrant pine trees and lush gardens. Discover the diverse coral lagoon, with glass bottom boat tours revealing gardens of coral and colorful tropical fish. To the south of Emily Bay's clear, tempting waters, the small Philip Island stands stark against the blue, with flashes of bright orange ochre and greenery painting its steep cliffs.



MANDATORY FACE TO FACE IMMIGRATION INSPECTION

Upon arrival in Norfolk Island, Australian Border Force (ABF) will perform a **Mandatory Face-To-Face Immigration Inspection for all guests. This will take place from approximately 7:00 a.m. in S.A.L.T. Kitchen on Deck 4.** Guests will be called over the PA system by your departure time, and then by deck. Please wait until you are called. Your passport will be handed to you inside the S.A.L.T. Kitchen prior to the inspection. Please complete both sides of the **Australian Incoming Passenger Card - IPC** and bring it with you (**one card is required per person**).

AUSTRALIAN BIOSECURITY REGULATIONS

This is an important message from the Australian Government. Australia has strict biosecurity laws that affect you. Before leaving the cruise ship for your experience ashore, all food must be left onboard. Any food you have should be left in your cabin or disposed of in the bins provided onboard. This includes items such as fresh fruit, sandwiches, yoghurt, milk, bacon, ham, sausages and eggs. Thank you for your attention and for supporting Australia's biosecurity.

Walking or Drive distance to downtown: approximately 10 to 15 minutes depending on the traffic. First bus from the pier is at 8:30 a.m. and last bus from the city is at 4:00 p.m.
