Beaches, Forests, and the Meeting of Two Seas

The Tasman Sea on the west and the Pacific Ocean on the east meet at the top of the North Island at Cape Reinga. No matter what route you take, you'll pass farms and forests, marvelous beaches, and great open spaces. The East Coast, up to the Bay of Islands, is Northland's most densely populated, often with escapees from bigger cities "looking for a more relaxed life" clustered around breathtaking beaches. The first decision on the drive north comes at the foot of the Brynderwyn Hills. Turning left will take you up the West Coast through areas once covered with forests and now used for either agriculture or horticulture. Driving over "the Brynderwyns," as they are known, takes you to Whangarei, the only city in Northland. If you're in the mood for a diversion, you can slip to the beautiful coastline and take in Waipu Cove, an area settled by Scots, and Laings Beach, where million-dollar homes sit next to small Kiwi beach houses. An hour's drive farther north is the Bay of Islands, known worldwide for its beauty. There you will find lush forests, splendid beaches, and shimmering harbors. The Treaty of Waitangi was signed here in 1840 between the Māori and the British Crown, establishing the basis for the modern New Zealand state. Every year on February 6, the extremely beautiful Waitangi Treaty Ground (the name means weeping waters) is the sight of a celebration of the treaty and protests by Māori unhappy with it. Continuing north on the East Coast, the agricultural backbone of the region is even more evident and a series of winding loop roads off the main highway will take you to beaches that are both beautiful and isolated where you can swim, dive, picnic, or just laze.

NEW ZEALAND BIOSECURITY REGULATIONS

New Zealand biosecurity regulations prohibit the removal of ship's stores from the vessel. Items that cannot be taken off the vessel include: Fresh fruit and vegetables; Meat of any kind; Prepared meals (including sandwiches); Dairy products; Any other food items; Flowers, seeds, or plants; Guests and crew may be asked to present their hand luggage, including backpacks for inspection to the MPI inspectors stationed at the gangway.
