DARWIN, AUSTRALIA

A New-Found paradise for salties

Australia's capital of the north is a uniquely tropical city and a historically isolated outpost of this vast and diverse country. Reaching up toward the equator, a full 2,000 miles from Sydney and Melbourne, the city was named in honour of Charles Darwin by the British settlers who established a frontier outpost here. With a unique history, beautiful islands nearby, and a palette of sizzling Pacific flavours, colourful Darwin is an enchanting and exotic Australian destination.

Crocodiles patrol the jungled waterways and tropical rainforests around Australia's gateway to the Top End. Explore via airboat to look down on the veined waterways of the mist-laced Kakadu National Park. The sounds of chattering birdlife and the gentle splash of fountains and waterfalls fill the air in the George Brown Darwin Botanic Gardens. Soak it all in before kicking back and relaxing with a picnic and a crackling barbecue.

The sunshine and famous tropical pink sunsets draw many visitors naturally to the city's soft sands, especially at pretty Mindil Beach as evening approaches. The adjoining market, filled with souvenirs and craft stalls, is the perfect place to enjoy fiery Asian flavours. Stroll the stalls, sample the food, and crack open an ice-frosted beer as the sunset show begins.

Although remote, Darwin found itself on the front line during the Pacific War, when the Japanese air force bombed the city in 1942. This relaxed, unassuming city has a deeply resilient backbone, however. You can explore the museums to learn more about the war's impact on Darwin, as well as the devastating effects of one of Australia's worst natural disasters, Cyclone Tracy in 1973.

SHUTTLE BUS

A complimentary continuous shuttle bus service will operate between the Pier and the Top End Visitor Information Centre from 7:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. We recommend arriving at least five minutes prior to the scheduled shuttle departure time at the designated pickup locations.

Please allow up to 10 minutes—depending on your walking pace—to reach the shuttle bus.

Estimated travel time to downtown is approximately 10 to 15 minutes, depending on traffic conditions.

AUSTRALIAN BIOSECURITY

This is an important message from the Australian Government. Australia has strict biosecurity laws that affect you. Before leaving the cruise ship for your experience ashore, all food must be left onboard. Any food you have should be left in your cabin or disposed of in the bins provided onboard. This includes items such as fresh fruit, sandwiches, yoghurt, milk, bacon, ham, sausages and eggs. Thank you for your attention and for supporting Australia's biosecurity.

AUSTRALIAN TOURIST REFUND SCHEME (TRS)

TRS service is available onboard in the **Panorama Lounge on Deck 9, from 9:45 a.m. to 10:45 a.m.**

Refunds may be claimed for eligible goods purchased in Australia totaling more than AUD 300 (including GST) from the same Australian Business Number (ABN). Please present your passport, original receipts, and the purchased goods to the Australian Border Force (ABF).

SAVE THE WAVES
