SHUTTLE SERVICE

A complimentary Shuttle Bus Service will be operating between the pier and to The Pearls of Umhlangae from 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. (last bus from city). Distance to downtown: approximately a 45-minute drive (one way). We recommend arriving at least 10 minutes prior to the shuttle bus departure at the pickup locations. Shuttle bus schedule will be posted at the Shore Concierge Desk, Deck 5 and at the gangway.

TIPS FOR STAYING SAFE

Currently, pickpockets and muggers tend to prey on tourists. Your safety is our main concern. Please exercise care when going ashore with wallets, handbags, sunglasses and camera equipment. Avoid highly visible jewellery, handbags or expensive-looking watches, sunglasses or camera equipment. Do not use large denominations when paying street vendors as this may attract unwanted attention. Do not accept food or drinks from strangers. Avoid walking around the port area, unaccompanied, especially after dark. Use licensed taxis and keep to the main streets when unsure of your surroundings.

AN ALERT FOR THE AFRICAN REGION

In Africa, mosquitos and insects increase after sundown. Please close curtains, turn off veranda lights, use repellent, and cover arms and legs. Protect yourself from the sun with sunscreen and a hat. Use hand sanitizer, eat carefully ashore, and drink bottled water only. Please ask permission before taking photos and be mindful of laws when buying items made from animal products. Thank you for your cooperation.
