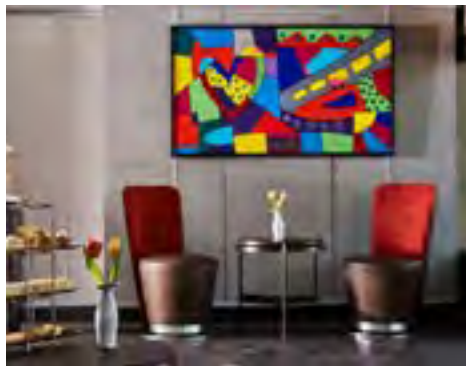

# LUANDA, ANGOLA

*Commonly known as "Paris of Africa"*

Luanda, the capital and largest city of Angola, is often referred to as the "Paris of Africa" because of its vibrant culture, cosmopolitan atmosphere, and traces of European-style architecture. Situated along the Atlantic Ocean, the city blends scenic coastal views with a dynamic urban landscape, where modern high-rises stand beside historic buildings that reflect its colonial past.

Founded by the Portuguese in 1575, Luanda has a long and complex history that has shaped its identity today. It was once a major center of the transatlantic slave trade, later evolving into an administrative and economic hub during colonial rule. Following Angola's independence in 1975, Luanda remained at the heart of the nation's political and cultural life despite enduring years of civil conflict.

Today, Luanda is one of Africa's fastest-growing cities, driven largely by its oil industry and expanding economy. It is a city of striking contrasts, where wealth and development coexist with challenges such as overcrowding and inequality. Despite this, Luanda continues to thrive as a center of resilience, creativity, and opportunity in modern Africa.
